

Carriage for Forklift

Carriage - There are 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capability. Hook type fork carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted forks vary by the amount of offset between the blade and the fork eye. Some manufacturers would vary the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
